Biotec claim the British Chamber's Achievement in International Business Award

A global pharmaceutical specialist that has seen sales increase by 517% in five years has been awarded the Achievement in International Business title at the British Chambers of Commerce Chamber Awards.

Biotec Services International, which employs 52 people at its Bridgend facility in South Wales, beat off competition from hundreds of companies to win the prestigious title, sponsored by DHL Express.
